## Pre-Installation Checklist

### BlackBerry Enterprise Server

Requirements:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. BlackBerry Enterprise Server v4.0 or higher</li><li>2. BlackBerry Mobile Data Service running <sup>1</sup></li><li>3. BlackBerry Enterprise Server is configured as a push server <sup>1</sup></li><li>4. Mobile Data Service configured to store push submissions in the management database <sup>1</sup></li><li>5. Mobile Data Service is configured to send the email address and PIN number of a BlackBerry device with each HTTP request from the BlackBerry Browser <sup>2</sup></li><li>6. The BlackBerry Enterprise Server must be able to ping the web server hosting PINpoint by IP address and DNS name</li></ol>

Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><input type="checkbox"/> Windows 2003 Server Standard or Web Edition, Windows 2008<sup>2</sup> Server Standard or Web Edition</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Member server of an Active Directory domain <sup>1</sup></li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Microsoft .NET Framework Version 3.5 SP1 installed</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Internet Information Server (IIS) installed</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> IIS Web Service Extension ASP.Net V2.0.xxxx allowed<sup>2</sup></li><li><input type="checkbox"/> Microsoft ASP.NET enabled</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> The web server hosting PINpoint must be able to ping the BlackBerry Management Database server by IP address and DNS name.</li><li><input type="checkbox"/> The web server hosting PINpoint must be able to ping the BlackBerry Enterprise Server by IP address and DNS name</li></ul>
