cDir is a web application that provides users with easy access to this vault of corporate knowledge, in a controlled and secure way, from their mobile devices.



cDir gives mobile users the ability to access information stored in your organization's Corporate Directory. Users can easily perform queries such as "list all engineers in the Boston office", and then click on a name to get information such as *address, phone numbers, a photograph, department manager, assistant, map location based on postal code or ZIP, equipment assigned, etc.* All in real-time from a mobile device!

cDir works with any mobile device, including BlackBerry® smartphone, BlackBerry® PlayBook, Apple iPhone, Apple iPad, Windows Mobile, notebooks, netbooks and slate PC's.

In addition to displaying information from LDAP directories, cDir also has the ability to query web servers or any data sources that return HTML, including web services wrapped around your corporate applications and databases (e.g. CRM, ERP, SQL, etc).

cDir goes beyond the basic function of finding information about people. It just as easily finds and displays information about any entities defined in your directories, such as groups, servers, departments, assets, and much more!
